Sunbury Area Health Foundation Donates \$25,000 to Sunbury Medical Clinic

Sunbury, PA - The newly formed Sunbury Area Health Foundation recently recently awarded its first grant in the amount of \$25,000 to A Community Clinic, Inc. in Sunbury. The Sunbury Auxiliary contributed \$6,000 of this grant through proceeds raised at their annual Love-n-Care Street Fair.

A Community Clinic, Inc. opened its doors in 2000 to provide free medical care for individuals who do not have medical insurance and are not eligible for federal, state or private medical insurance programs. Since its inception the clinic has seen over 2,400 patients.

The Sunbury Area Health Foundation (SAHF) is a charitable foundation that was created from the sale of the Sunbury Hospital in 2005 with assets just over \$3 million.

Soon after its formation, the SAHF partnered with the Central Susquehanna Community Foundation (CSCF) which allows the SAHF to continue its stated purpose of improving health care in the region while moving forward towards greater growth of the Foundation funds.

The CSCF's purpose is to encourage increased philanthropy that will benefit the charities and communities located in this region, improving the quality of life today and for generations to come. The community foundation provides a vehicle for individuals, businesses, and nonprofit organizations to help their community through charitable giving.
